

Federal work study

Are you looking for a part-time job to work around your college schedule? SUVA provides Federal Work Study (FWS) opportunities to eligible financial aid students. As an FWS employee, you have the prospect of working on campus. FWS jobs are a great opportunity to network, add valuable job-related skills, and obtain income while you are attending college.

Eligibility requirements

1. Completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
2. Complete all requirements associated with the FAFSA application and college
3. Achieve satisfactory academic progress
4. Enroll at least half-time status (6 credit hours or more)
5. Have available unmet financial need (or are willing to reduce currently awarded student loans)

How do I apply?

If you believe you meet the Federal Work Study criteria, we welcome you to apply for as many FWS positions as you would like.

Once your application(s) are received they will be reviewed by the hiring managers for that position. Your application will remain available for the entire academic year (fall, spring, summer) unless your financial aid eligibility status changes. If your application meets the hiring criteria, you will be contacted by the hiring manager for an interview. If you have any questions regarding FWS you can make an appointment with Enrollment Management.

There is no guarantee of employment. There is a chance that you will not be called for an interview even if you apply. All FWS positions are a part of a competitive hiring process. Southwest University of Visual Arts is an equal opportunity employer.

If you are selected for a position you will be contacted to complete your new hire paperwork. This must be completed before you can start working. All FWS jobs pay minimum wage.
